Aerona IPAFFS Notification / Pre notification

This charge covers Aerona's preparation and submission of the IPAFFS notification and associated pre-arrival documentation. Any statutory port health, BCP, CHED, veterinary inspection, laboratory, sampling, examination, IUU, catch certificate or other official control charges are additional and will be charged at cost.

Where IPAFFS notification is required, the importer or their appointed agent must ensure that the required notification is submitted before the consignment arrives in Great

Britain. Aeronas can prepare and submit the IPAFFS notification on the importer's behalf for £55 per consignment.

Where pre-notification is required, IPAFFS notifications must be submitted within the applicable statutory notification period before arrival. Customers must provide Aeronas with complete and accurate documentation sufficiently to allow the notification to be prepared and submitted on time.

Our Agency Administration /Disbursement fee

These are charge because importing live animals can involve considerable amounts of time and coordination between:

- HMRC
- Port Health
- Border Control Posts
- Shipping line
- Cargo terminals
- Importers
- Hauliers
- Laboratories
- Veterinary authorities
- Other government agencies.

Aerona may therefore incur government agencies additional charge on behalf of the importer.

Aerona SPS and Port Health Agency Administration /Disbursement fee - £55-£75 Flat Fee

An Agency Administration charge of £55 - £75.00 Flat fee is applicable for all SPS (Sanitary Phytosanitary shipments) requiring port health BCP involvement. This covers Aerona's administration, document coordination, document checks, communication and liaison with Port Health, Border Control Post and other relevant authorities. Statutory government charges are charged at cost.

This charge does not replace the actual third-party charges costs which remain payable by the importer.

Additional and Complex SPS administration- £95 per hour (Minimum 1hr)

A charge of £95 per hour will be applicable where a shipment requires physical examination attendance, extensive correspondence, document amendments, non-compliance management, Rejected documentation, corrective actions, sampling instruction, veterinary examination, laboratory coordination, multiple authority interventions or other work outside the standard clearance process.

*** Some live animal customs clearance cases can be more complex and may require additional work, communication and confirmation to resolve the matter and obtain customs clearance.

This may include situations involving:

- Missing or incomplete documentation.
- Incorrect or inconsistent documentation
- Customs queries or request for further information
- Multiple amendments to customs declaration.
- Additional correspondence with customs or other relevant authorities
- Unexpected issues at the airport or point of arrival
- Extensive liaison with government and other port authorities, airlines or other parties

Where additional work is required, our specialist fish import customs clearance team will assess the circumstances and explain any additional requirements or charges before proceeding wherever possible.

Our aim is to resolve customs clearance issues efficiently while providing the careful, professional and sensitive service required when dealing with your fish import.

HMRC and where applicable, Border Force or other relevant authorities may review the documentation and require further information before release.

- Importers GB EORI
- Commercial Invoice
- Packing list
- Freight Ticket
- Commodity information
- Country of origin
- Supplier details
- Customs value
- Incoterms
- Health Certificate, where applicable
- Animal passport, where applicable
- IPAFF Registration and information
- Any applicable import licence or authorisation.

Before Arrival:

Aerona should receive the complete documentation sufficiently in advance to allow the relevant customs and SPS declaration to be prepared and submitted within the applicable notification periods.

Your responsibility as the importer of record

The importer remains responsible for ensuring that:

- The animals are legally permitted to enter Great Britain
- The importer has the required EORI registration
- The importer is appropriately registered for the relevant animal and SPS requirements.
- Required certificates are obtained from the overseas supplier and exporters authority.
- Information supplied to Aerona is complete and accurate
- Required notifications are made within the applicable statutory timescales.

Aerona will use reasonable care when preparing customs and SPS declarations based on the information supplied by the importers.

Aerona cannot accept responsibility for costs arising from inaccurate, incomplete, late or misleading information supplied by the importer, supplier, carrier or another party.
